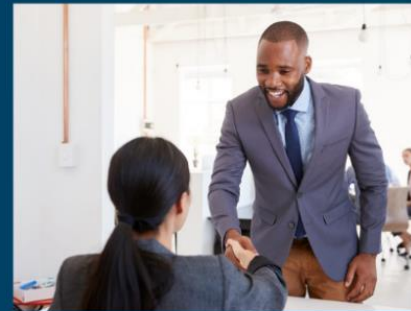

- Program Quality Director–elect Theresa Flynn will be planning summer training

- Remaining Area & Division trophies will be distributed by Area & Division Directors
- Division Directors that don't have trophies:
 - Robert will contact you directly to make sure logistics make sense
 - The default plan is to ship boxes of trophies to Division Directors for distribution
 - For contestants outside the geographic area, the district will ship directly to them

The New Pathways

2024 Pathways Rollout

- We're told that the new Pathways will roll out sometime in 2024
 - That is still literally all the information we have regarding scheduling
 - Except we were told there would be a 45-day advance notice
 - And we haven't received that notice yet
- We've seen screenshots of a preview
 - It looks intuitive enough that additional training will not be needed
 - But the incoming Trio is still planning to offer training after the rollout

The Path to Distinguished

- To be a distinguished district, we need:
 - 83 clubs (72 to date – 86.7%)
 - 2,510 member payments (2,359 to date – 94%)
 - 34 distinguished clubs (8 to date – 23.25%)
- This means that we need distinguished clubs. To do that:
 - Clubs need to renew and/or add members
 - Clubs need to turn in awards
 - Clubs need to actually be thinking about being distinguished
- This incentive targets these three things

Winter Freeze

- Rationale:
 - Maintaining club membership is critical to success
 - It's tempting for some clubs to “leave it for next year”
 - Which means that nobody thinks about it until August – not good
- What you need to do:
 - End the year on 6-30-24 with as many members as you had on 1-1-24
- What you get:
 - Same number of members as 1-1-24 = banner ribbon
 - More members than 1-1-24 = \$10 District Dollars

Spring Cleaning

- Rationale:
 - Many members have levels that are only a speech or two away
 - Some members even have levels that are turned in and not approved
 - Those levels will help the member achieve and the club be distinguished
- What you need to do:
 - Complete and turn in Pathways levels in May and June (Base Camp and Club Central)
- What you get:
 - 2 levels turned in = \$10 District Dollars
 - 4 levels turned in = \$15 District Dollars
 - 6 levels turned in = \$20 District Dollars

Summer Vacation

- Rationale:
 - Achieving goals early is ideal
 - It also provides “wiggle room” if things don’t go quite as planned
- What you need to do:
 - Achieve any level of Distinguished status by June 1, including:
 - 5 or more DCP points
 - 20 or more members or a net growth of 3 (membership requirement)
- What you get:
 - \$25 District Dollars

The Fall Finish

- Rationale:
 - Clubs that consistently recruit members, turn in awards promptly, and focus on achieving goals early are likely to have ongoing success
- What you need to do:
 - Earn all three of:
 - Any level of “Winter Freeze”
 - Any level of “Spring Cleaning”
 - “Summer Vacation”
- What you get:
 - \$30 District Dollars → in addition to the District Dollars from above

- Don't hesitate to reach out and ask for help
