Realignment Purpose

- Life is change, and Toastmasters is no different – members come and go, clubs come and go.
- Each year, we need to submit to Toastmasters International an alignment plan to place clubs in Areas and Divisions
 - 4-6 Clubs per Area
 - 3+ Areas per Division
- Many Areas are now out of alignment and we need to update them - we are recommending changes to set the District on a path for future growth

Realignment Methodology

- Primarily use geography to collect clubs into Areas
- Stay away from creating 6-Club Areas to allow for future growth and to allow Area Directors to focus more on each of their clubs

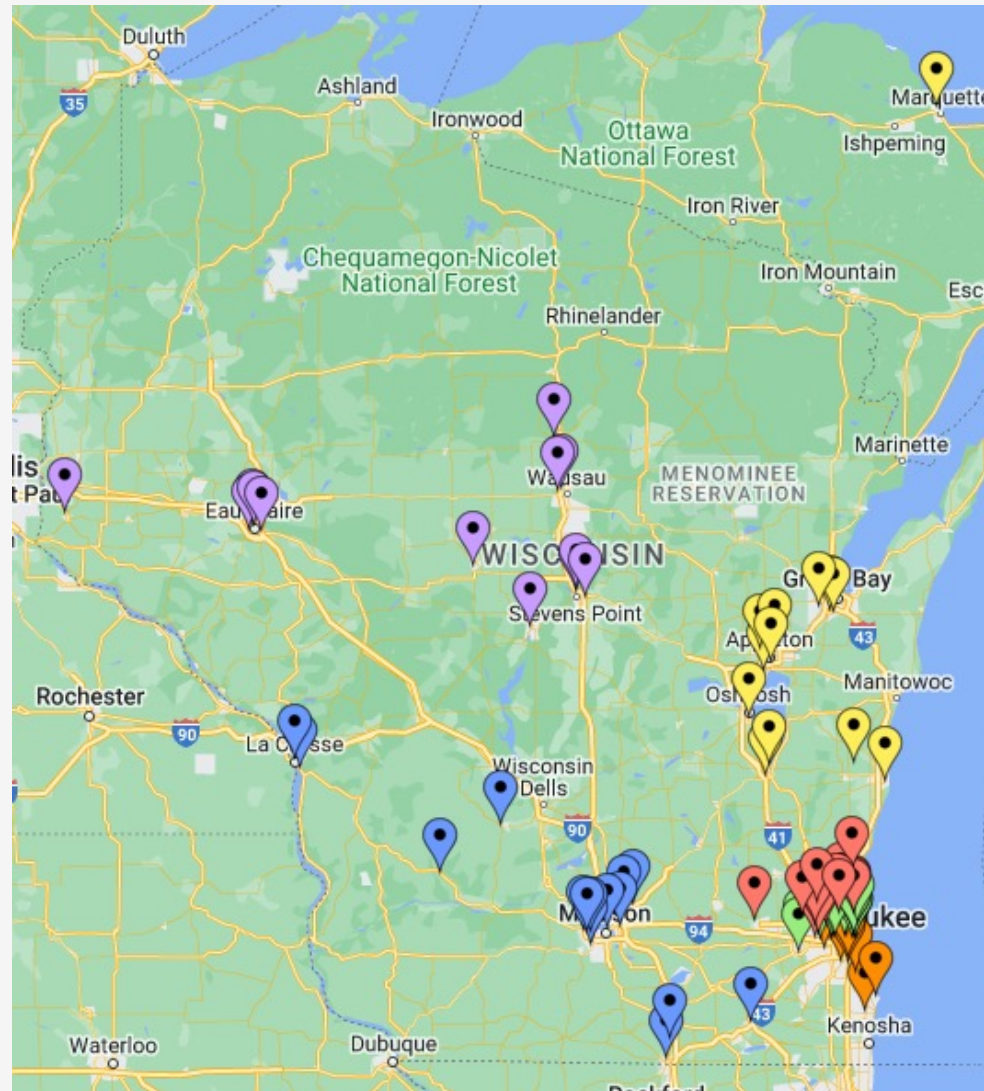
Why Remove a Division?

- The bare minimum number of clubs in a Division is 12; B is at 11 now
- The number of clubs in ABDF right now is 49 – with five clubs that are closing (minimum for four Divisions is 48)
- Better to have three robust SE Wisconsin Divisions – plenty of room to grow in future years
- Most importantly, there were only six candidates this year for seven Division Director positions

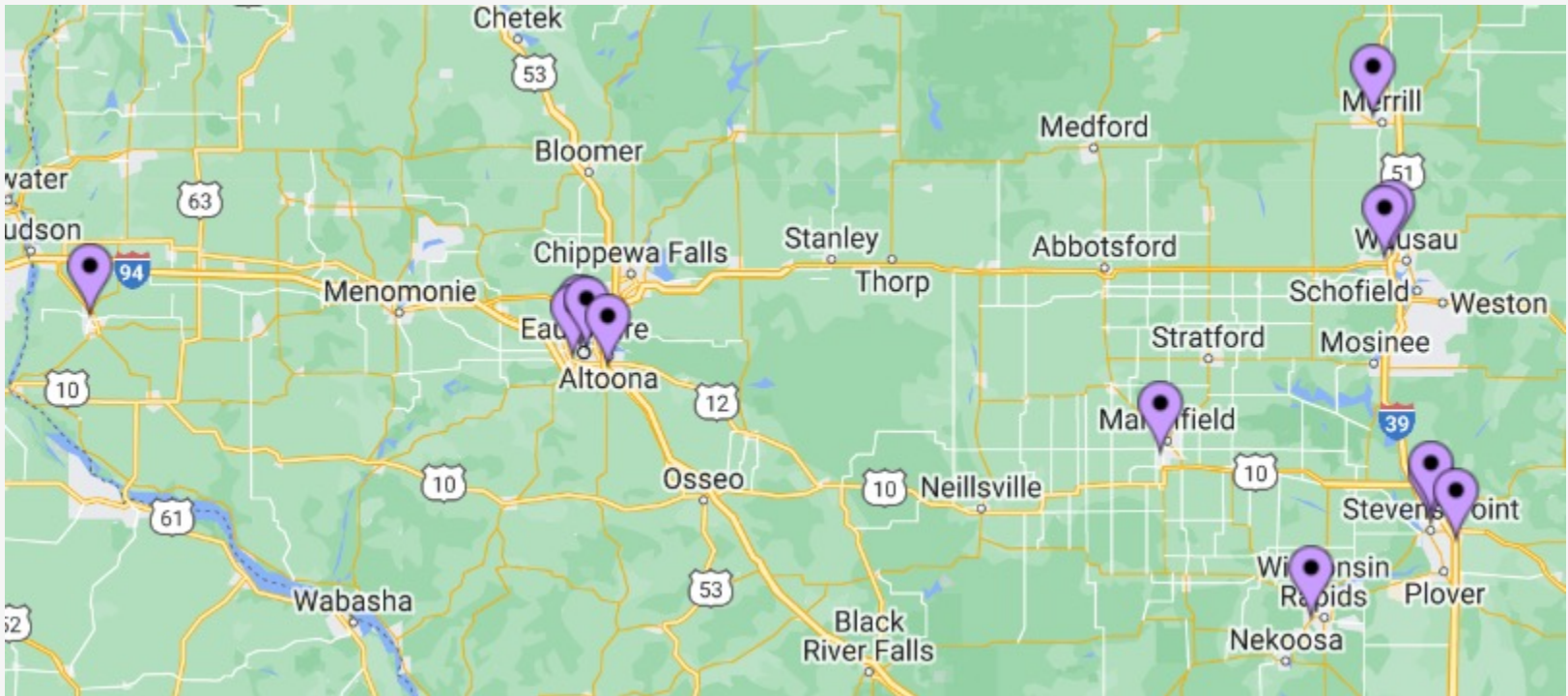
