Attendees of the 2019 Spring Convention will have the ability to attend two (2) of six (6) breakout sessions. Breakout sessions will be available in the morning and in the afternoon. Each Breakout Session has a seating capacity of 75 people. It is not a requirement that an Education Session speaker is a current Toastmaster member, however, most attendees are affiliated with the organization and it is strongly advised that speakers ensure their topic applies to the mission and principles of the Toastmasters organization and specifically applicable to people who are focused on the development of their communication and leadership skills.

Education Sessions are intended to be informational in nature and not a sales promotion. Speakers are limited in promoting any product/service associated with the subject matter of the session, any company they are associated with, and any product/service they personally sell. The following is acceptable as part of the session delivery:

- Referencing various resources related to the topic.
- Promoting (but not selling) any books they have written on the subject matter or related topics; provided the promotion is at the end of the session as part of closing remarks.
- Providing their business contact information to the attendees.
- Including a short paragraph statement on their business or company at the close of the workshop
