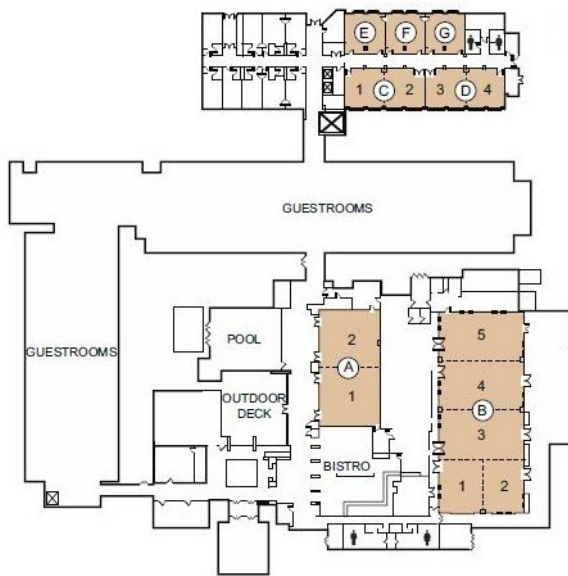

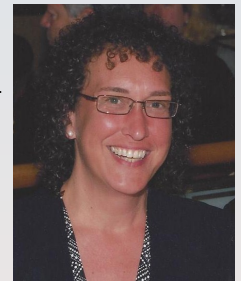

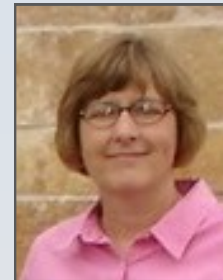
Andrew Little, DTM, 2011-2013 International Director
